Central Mongolia 3 days











Day 1: Pick up from your hotel after breakfast around 9am. Drive to Khugnu Khan Nature Reserve — It is a picturesque area of the Rocky Mountains, semi-desert, Gobi sand dunes and steppes all in one location represents three different natural zones. It is ideal location for hiking, wildlife observation, and photography. After lunch, take a short drive to Uvgun Monastery in the national park through the semi-desert and the Rocky Mountains. In the afternoon, we will visit a local nomadic family and explore their nomadic lifestyle which has not changed for centuries.

Day 2: After breakfast, short drive to Elsen tasarkhai /The mini Gobi/ sand dunes - surrounded by hills with willow trees, streams and bushes, appear as a small desert in the center of the country. This sand dune is 80km long and the part of the sand dune is The sand dunes are the perfect place for camel riding. We will discover this magnificent place on camelback. Continue driving to Kharhorin, the ancient capital of the Mongolian Empire, located 400km southwest of UB. There are presently efforts to reestablish Kharhorin as the capital of Mongolia as it was centuries ago. Explore the restored Erdenzuu Monastery originally built in 1586. Then we will drive to Ugii Lake - is a pure water steppe lake, which is 7.9km long, 5km wide. There are 14 kinds of fishes also, it is home to 144 kinds of birds. Stay overnight at ger camp near the lake.

Day 3: Around 8 am, we'll drive back to Ulaanbaatar. On the way, we will visit Khustai National Park. This area is home to the Mongolian wild horse known as Przewalski horse (takhi). Visit the park Information center. After lunch we will take a short drive to see for wild horse Takhi. It is a great opportunity to see these endangered horses. If you are lucky, you might see fox, deer, roe deer, eagle, and more animals and birds. Then drive to Ulaanbaatar.

What's Included: Meals (lunch on the first day through lunch on the last day), English speaking guide, vehicle/driver park/entry fees, and ger accommodations.

What's Not Included: Roundtrip international airfare to/from UB, hotel in UB, airport taxes, evacuation coverage, gratuities, excess baggage fees and items of personal nature.

Note: It is private tour and will serve only for your group. No other travelers will join in your group. It can be added after your trip as an extension. Please contact us for price, we're flexible.

Driving hours and distance in the countryside will vary depending on road and weather conditions. Often time roads are very dusty, bumpy and very challenging.
