



PROJECT INTRODUCTION

Project for Market and Pasture Management Development (PMPMD) has been implemented by Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Light Industry in 18 soums of 6 target aimags from May 2018 to September 2021, with additional funding from International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) of United Nations.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The goal of PMPMD is to contribute to empower poor rural women and men to achieve higher incomes and sustainable improvements in their livelihoods.

The PMPMD has 3 components: (a) Pasture management and climate change adaptation; (b) Market development; and (c) Project management and enabling environment for business development.

In the scope of Pasture Management and Climate Change Adaptation Component, totally 144 Pasture Herders Groups (PHG) have been set up; agreed on 3 years' pasture management plan by inclusive integrated approach, and series of trainings on pasture management and risk management for herders and soum administratives are provided. Under the partnership with Mongolian National Federation of Pasture Users and Onison Tulkhuur NGO, the project is supporting Revolving funds of PHGs to adapt and overcome climate change on the basis of needs and demand of the soums and the herders' groups.

The Project Components

Component 1. Pasture Management and Climate Change Adaptation

In the scope of Pasture Management and Climate Change Adaptation Component, totally 144 Pasture Herders Groups (PHG) have been set up; agreed on 3 years' pasture management plan by inclusive integrated approach, and series of trainings on pasture management and risk management for herders and soum administratives are provided. Under the partnership with Mongolian National Federation of Pasture Users and Onison Tulkhuur NGO, the project is supporting Revolving funds of PHGs to adapt and overcome climate change on the basis of needs and demand of the soums and the herders' groups. The following supporting activities are implemented: dig bore well, sheep dips, rodent control, hay shed and fodder storage, risk fund, improving livestock quality and breeding, and Herders Information center.

Component 2. Market development

This component has supported women's groups for business proposal and capacity building, and rural micro, SMEs for business plans development and capacity building activities. It will continue to support of concessional micro loans and loan guarantee for the groups, cooperatives and local micro and small business entities; to connect the Group Savings funds to Savings and Credit Cooperatives.
