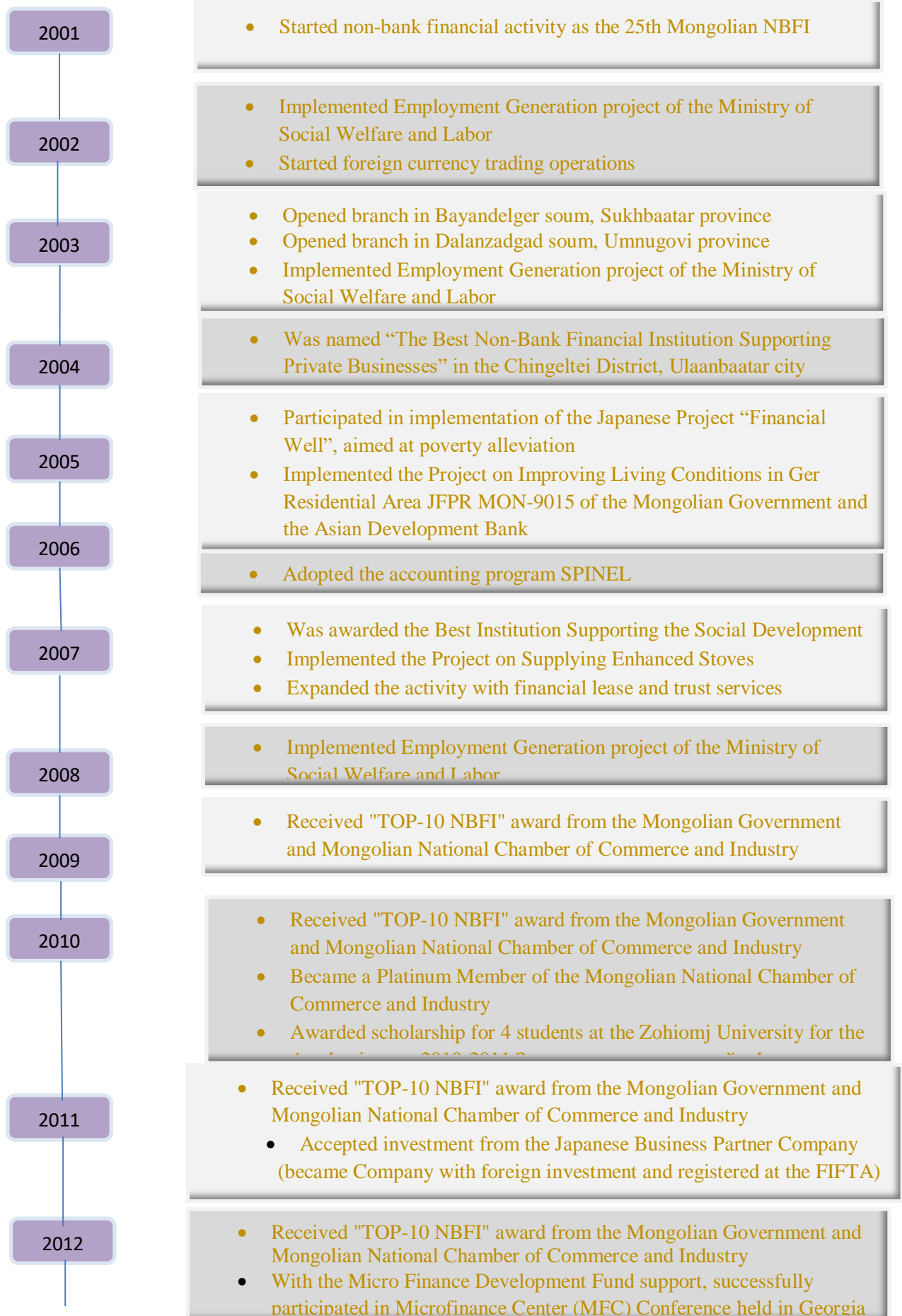


## ABTS NBFI CHRONOLOGY



2013

- The nationwide online public opinion poll through [www.khunnu.mn](http://www.khunnu.mn) website named the ABTS NBFi as “THE BEST NBFi OF 2013”

2014

- Received long-term foreign financing of USD 2 mln in mid-May, which translated into corresponding expansion of our loan market and funding for individuals, legal entities, and SME in a short period of three months through an effective advertisement methods such as newspaper and radio advertisements, stickers on the crowded bus handles

2015

- In May, received mid-term foreign financing of USD 500,000 that facilitated further growth of our loan market share and lending activity
- Supported young talent in publishing his poetry book

2016

- Mongolian Non-Bank Financial Institutions Association awarded and titled ABTS NBFi as the “Best Investor of the Year”.
- Received foreign financing equivalent to JPY 425 mln for enhancing the lending activity

2017

- Presented gifts to children from poor and low-income households of Chingeltei District on Children’s Day
- Implemented the seventh project of Micro Finance Development Fund, Mongolia

2018

- Supported 12 female-headed households through our loan products
