The Cambridge program is designed for students aged 5-19 in 10,000 schools in 160 countries. The program has four main levels: Cambridge Primary, Cambridge Lower Secondary, Cambridge Upper Secondary (IGCSE), and Cambridge Advanced (AS & A). In addition, our school has been officially authorized to offer the IGCSE and AS & A level programs officially.

We started implementing the Cambridge Upper Secondary (IGCSE) program in the 9th-grade in the 2021-2022 academic year.

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Why did our school start the Cambridge IGCSE program?

To fulfill our school's mission, we have applied for the international baccalaureate (IB) world school candidate in 2016. Since then, two cohorts have successfully achieved 100% of the bilingual diploma requirements, and the graduates of the program have enrolled in international and local universities with scholarships. Thus, to provide our students with more opportunities as early as possible, we are implementing the Cambridge IGCSE program in the 9th-grade starting from the 2021-2022 academic year.
