JAPANESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Duration of scholarship program: 1 year in preparatory class, 4 years in basic class (total 5 years)

You can study for 6 years in Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, and Pharmacy and get a bachelor's degree.

Preparatory training:

During the first year, students will receive intensive Japanese language training and other preparatory courses at the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies or at the Japanese Language Training Center at Osaka University.

Students who complete the preparatory course will be admitted to the university after passing the university entrance examination provided by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan. However, the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan decides which university to enroll in.

Examination during the selection:

- Japanese, English, Mathematics,
- Natural sciences Chemistry, Physics (A) / Biology (B)
- Scholarship amount: 117,000 yen per month
- Scholarship period: During the study period
- Tuition and round-trip airfare are the responsibility of the Japanese government

Requirements:

- Be a citizen of Mongolia
- To be born on April 2, 1997
- Must be a high school graduate (12th grade) in the year of application, or be a 1st or 2nd year student at a local university
- Must have a grade point average of 90 or higher in the last 3 years of high school, and a grade point average of 3.5 or higher in the case of a university student.
- Be physically and mentally healthy
- Probably not a military man
- Never studied on a Japanese government scholarship before
- No scholarships or plans to receive scholarships from other organizations

Registration: It takes place in April and May of each year and is available in two forms: online and by mail. Once the registration materials are received, the Embassy notifies you by email that you have received the materials.

Academic results
School description
Reference from the teacher in charge or the principal of the last graduate
Photo (Write your name on the back of the photo and paste it on the request form)
Foreign language test certificate (Please send if you have Japanese or English test certificate)
