Government of the People's Republic of China Scholarship Program

According to the Education Exchange and Cooperation Plan between the Ministry of Education and Science of Mongolia and the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, a certain number of Mongolian students receive bachelor's degree scholarships each year.

One. Requirements

- 1. Be a citizen of Mongolia and be healthy
- 2. Obtain a high school diploma or higher and a good academic record
- 3. The applicant should contact the applicant school in advance and determine in advance the major and language of study.
- 4. Scholarship recipients are not allowed to receive simultaneous funding from other scholarships and admissions offices at all levels set by the Chinese government. In case of intentional concealment of funding, the right to receive scholarships from the Chinese government will be revoked and the right to study on scholarships from the Chinese government will be revoked.
- If you want to study in Chinese, you must have HSK3 and above level knowledge

Two. Registration

Applicants must register on the Chinese International Students' Website at http://www.campuschina.org and submit their application.

Submit the following documents:

- 1. Chinese Government Scholarship Application Form (to be completed in Chinese or English);
- 2. The first page of the passport
 - Note: The applicant's passport must be valid. Send a scanned copy of the first page of the passport.
- 3. Certificate of education (notarized)
 - The applicant must submit a graduation certificate or admission certificate issued by the school where he/she is studying or graduating.
- 4. Transcripts
 - All documents must be translated into Chinese or English, notarized and accompanied by the original.
- 5. HSK, IELTS or TOEFL test results sheet
 - If you study in Chinese, you must have a valid HSK score;
 - To study English, submit an IELTS or TOEFL transcript;
- 6. Study plan
 - Have at least 200 words (written in Chinese or English);
- 7. Two letters of recommendation
 - Recommendation letters from two teachers who can best describe you, and they should be translated into English or Chinese and notarized.
- 8. A masterpiece work
 - Those who want to study a major in art or design can post a masterpiece (drawings, black drawings, etc.) through the "Creation/Other Auxiliary Materials";
- 9. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, submit the relevant legal documents of a legal guardian in China.
- 10. Fill out the "Foreigners' Health Examination Form"
 - Note: Keep the original and the form is printed by the Chinese Ministry of Health and Quarantine and must be completed in English).
 - The provisions of the "Foreigners' Health Examination Form" must be strictly adhered to.

- A "foreigner's medical examination sheet" shall be considered invalid if it is incomplete, does not have a photo of the person, does not have a stamp on the photo, and does not have a doctor's or hospital's signature or stamp.
- The test must be valid for 6 months.

11. Police reference

 The applicant must submit a reference confirming that the crime has not been registered or convicted by the local police. Reference must be valid within 6 months prior to the application.;

Three. Written exam and interview

Each year, the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Mongolia will hold a written examination and interview at a fixed time. Please fill in your contact details correctly when requesting, as you will be notified in a timely manner. Please note that those who submit non-compliant materials will not be allowed to take the test!

Four. About the priority occupations of enrollment

In order to improve the academic quality of scholarship entrants and to train personnel necessary for the economic and social development of Mongolia, the scholarship recipients will be trained in the priority occupations required by Mongolia, approved by the Annex to the Government Resolution No. 70.
