

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM

I. Requirements

1. Mongolian citizens studying in the 12th-grade of a secondary school in the year of application for the scholarship program must have a copy of a transcript to be 80+ or more.
2. A citizen of Mongolia who is a first-year student of an accredited Mongolian university or college must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. Not eligible for a government grant from another country

II. The professional field of study and number of scholarships

- International relations
- Tourism
- Food engineering
- Medicine
- Restoration of cultural heritage
- Water resource management
- Renewable energy

These majors are likely to change depending on the job requirements and may vary yearly. In addition, the number of entrants to the scholarship program varies from year to year within the number of scholarships.

III. Registration: Held annually in March-April

Visit <https://scholarship.esis.edu.mn/> to create a user account, read the manual for filling out and submitting an online application, and submit the application.

Each of the following documents mentioned in the application shall be attached to the "Documents" section in PDF format (1 file size should not exceed 5Mb).

Documents to be placed in the electronic registration system:

A high school graduate is:

- Electronic application
- A recommendation letter by the homeroom teacher;
- A letter expressing a desire to study in the Socialist Republic of Vietnam on a government scholarship (more than 500 words in Mongolian);
- A copy of transcripts of 11th-grade results;
- Copy of ID card;
- 3*4 size photos taken in the last 6 months will be submitted electronically;

Early registration is recommended as the system is overloaded as registration closes.

It is not possible to register additional citizens who are late, so please register within the specified time.

It is necessary to place authentic and correct documents in the electronic registration system. In case of forgery, the scholarship will be revoked.

IV. Selection

The selection has two stages.

- Compilation of documents. The scholarship program will evaluate the applicant's application, essay content, relevance, and self-expression.
- Interview. Depending on the circumstances of the pandemic, the selection process will be conducted electronically. The schedule of the online interview and the list of participants will be posted on the Ministry of Education and Science website.

All participants will be ranked according to the total score of the application and interview, and scholarships will be awarded to the highest scorers.
