SCHOLARSHIPS OF UKRAINE

A certain number of Mongolians are selected for the undergraduate scholarship program of Ukraine within the number of scholarships every year. Therefore, the number of students to be admitted may vary from year to year.

Undergraduate scholarship program opens: January-February of each year

The field of study is announced under the needs of the workplace that is in short supply every year.

The majors in the field of study:

- Aviation engineer
- Road engineer
- Railway engineer
- Road transport organization
- Medicine

Scholarship period: 4 years

Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must be a citizen of Mongolia under 21 years of age.
- 2. The average grade of the high school diploma must be above 80, and the average grade point average must be 3.0 or higher if a first- or second-year student of a university.
- 3. Not eligible for government grants from any country previously.
- 4. Must be fully prepared for the Russian language, have completed advanced Russian language courses, or graduate from a Mongolian-Russian joint secondary school with an average grade of 80 percent or more.

Selection process:

Electronic application (go to www.esis.edu.mn/grant, fill in the electronic application and upload the documents to the application)

The bachelor's degree scholarship awardee selection will be administered in the form of a written examination and an interview.

The Ministry of Education, Culture, Science and Sports will nominate successful applicants for scholarships from the relevant government.

The host party will make the final decision on the candidate's education. Government scholarships include tuition and living stipends. Other expenses (such as travel expenses and health insurance) are the student's responsibility.
