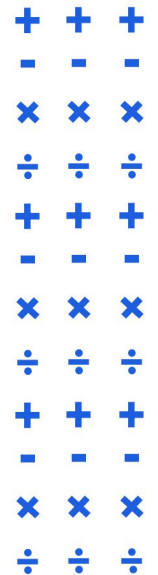

Mandakh University offers a range of scholarships to support domestic students including Scholarship for new students, President's grants, Scholarship for successful students and Scholarships for student leaders. These scholarships provide tuition fee discounts and other forms of financial assistance. Mandakh University has spent a total of 721,211,300 MNT on Scholarship programs over the past 10 years.

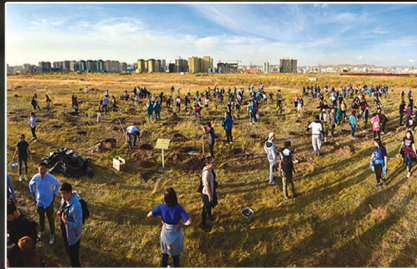

# History

## About MU

Mandakh University (MU) was established in 1992 during Mongolia's transition from a one-party political economy to a multi-party political free market economy, and was one of the first private universities in the country.

As global educational and scientific demands continue to evolve, we have set a goal to not only become a competitive university at the national level, but also at the international level by changing our policy attitudes.

Mandakh University's vision, as defined in its Strategic Plan for Development 2022-2027, is to become an internationally recognized academic and research university. To achieve this goal, the university has established strategic priorities and aims to become a leading research institution among Mongolia's private universities by 2027.

## History of University Development

### 1992 - 2002

- 1992 Founded by the initiative of Mr. Sandagsuren Budkhuu
- 1996 Changed its name to Mandakh Burtgel institute
- 1998 Organized the First National Accounting Olympiad among the Mongolian universities and Colleges
- 2000 Established Mandakh branch school at Dund-Govi province, Mongolia
- 2001 Won the 1st place in the Third National Accounting Olympiad among the Mongolian universities and Colleges
- 2002 Won the 1st place in the Fifth National Accounting Olympiad among the Mongolian universities and Colleges

### 2003 - 2013

- 2003 Winner of "Customer Delight Award"
- 2004 Listed in the top 10 ranked universities in Mongolia
- 2005 Conducted the training course on International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) and International Accounting Standards (IAS) for urban and rural accountants, financed by the Asian Development Fund.
- 2006 Accounting program has been accredited at national level
- 2007 Established branch school at Darkhan-Uul province
- 2010 Received an award "Best university and college" from the Association of Mongolian Private Universities and Colleges
- 2012 Hosted the 1st International Scientific Conference dedicated to the 20th anniversary of Mandakh University
- 2013 Bilateral meeting between Mandakh University and Tohoku University was held to discuss the possibility of working together in the future.

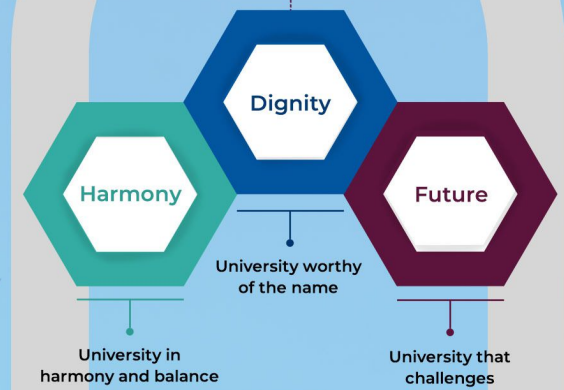
### 2014-Present

- 2014 During the ACBSP meeting in Chicago, USA, on June 27-30, 2014, officially announced that Mandakh Burtgel Institute has been accredited by ACBSP.
- 2015 Received a Honored Certificate of "Quality Certified School of the year 2015" from Mongolian Private Universities and Colleges and General Agency for Specialized Inspection.
- 2016 The MOU for cooperation was signed between Mandakh University and Institute of Business Management, India
- 2017 The First National Statistics Olympiad named after B.Sandagsuren, Founder of Mandakh University has been successfully organized
- 2018 Information Technology Department has been expanded as a School of Information and Technology, component school of Mandakh university
- 2019 The MOU for cooperation was signed between Mandakh university and Southern Cross university, Australia and Handong Global university, South Korea.
- 2020 Established Mandakh high school.
- 2021 Established Professional School of Accounting, School of Engineering and Economics and Graduate school
- 2022 Celebrated its 30th anniversary
- 2023 Established a new library building with 5 stories.
