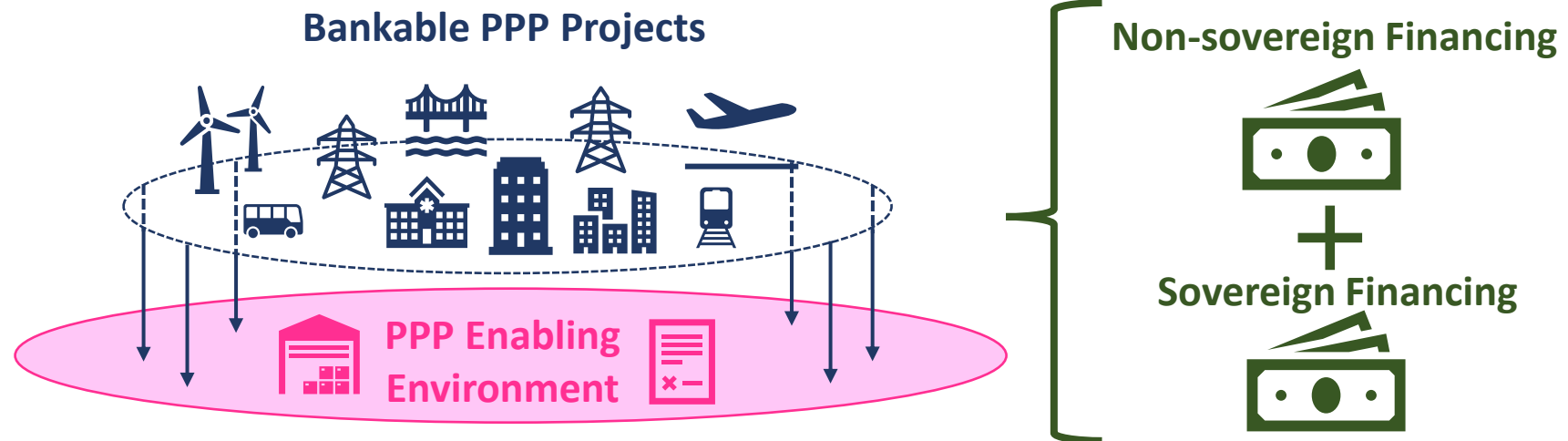
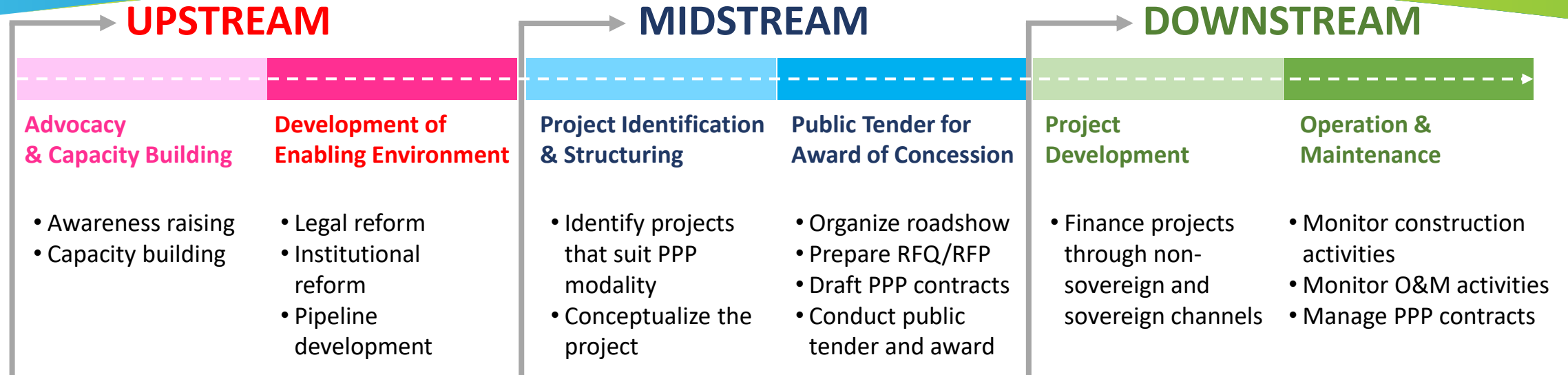

Legal Reform: Development of primary and secondary legislations, standard operational procedures, etc.



Institutional Reform: Establishment of a PPP center – design the organization, develop TOR, recruit initial staff, etc.



Capacity Development: PPP 101 training, APMG Certification Program, value-for-money analysis, etc.

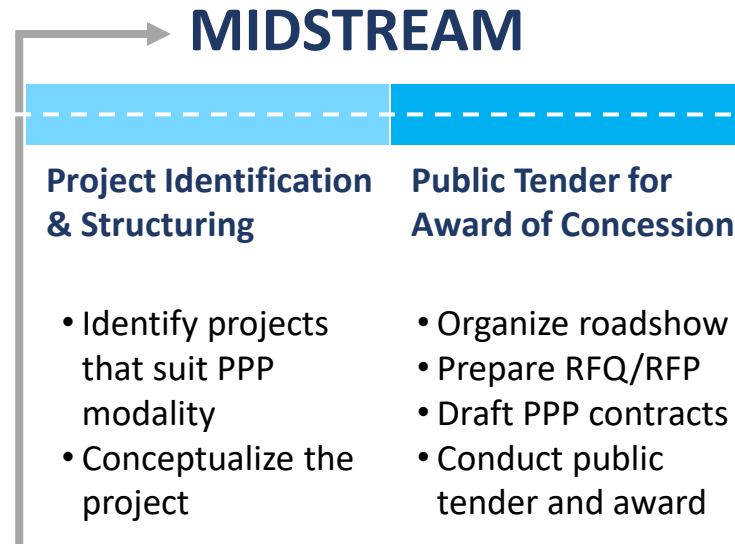

Country Partnership Strategy

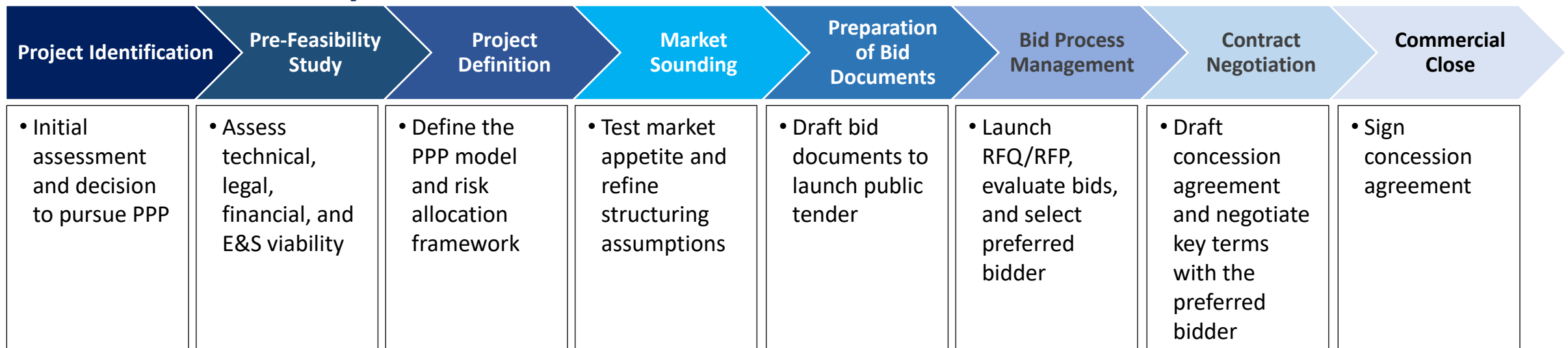
- ADB's primary platform for designing operations to deliver development results at the country level.

Transaction Advisory Workflow

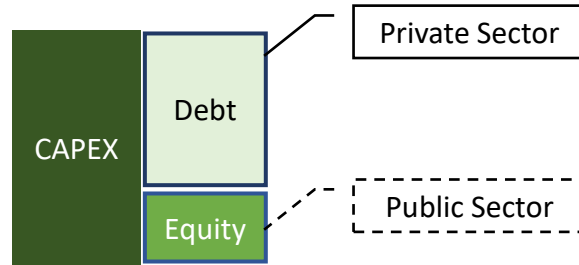

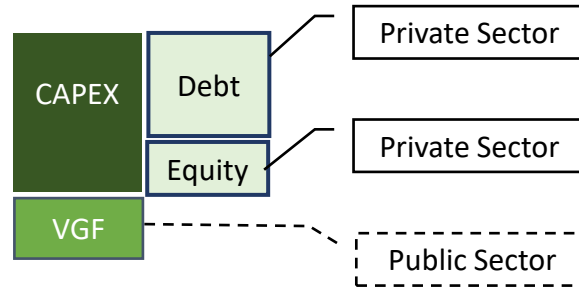

Sample Financing Structures

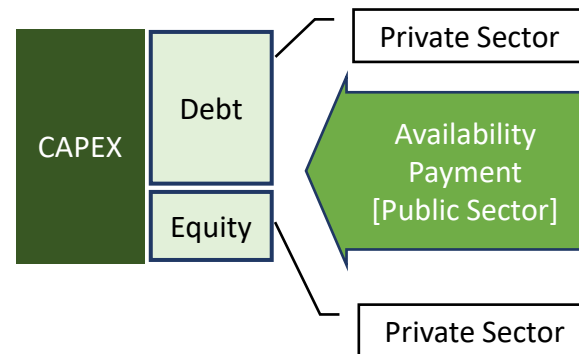
Private sector provides debt. Equity may be financed by public sector if government owns stakes.



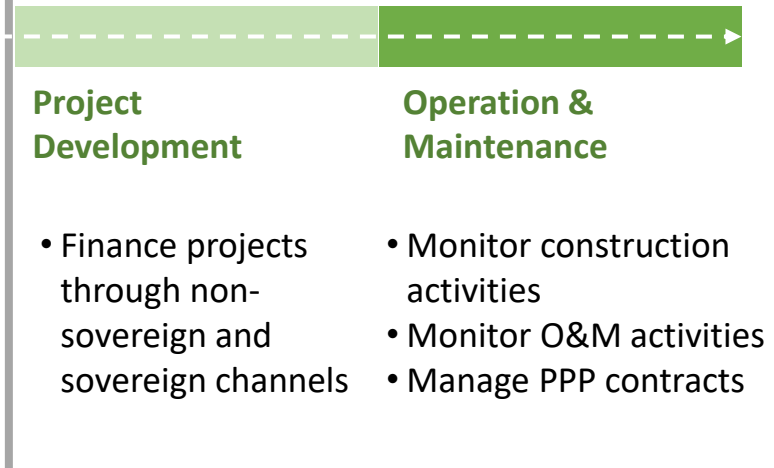
Government provides VGF financed by public sector to reduce required private capital (debt & equity).



Debt and equity are funded by private capital. Government provides AP which is funded by public sector.

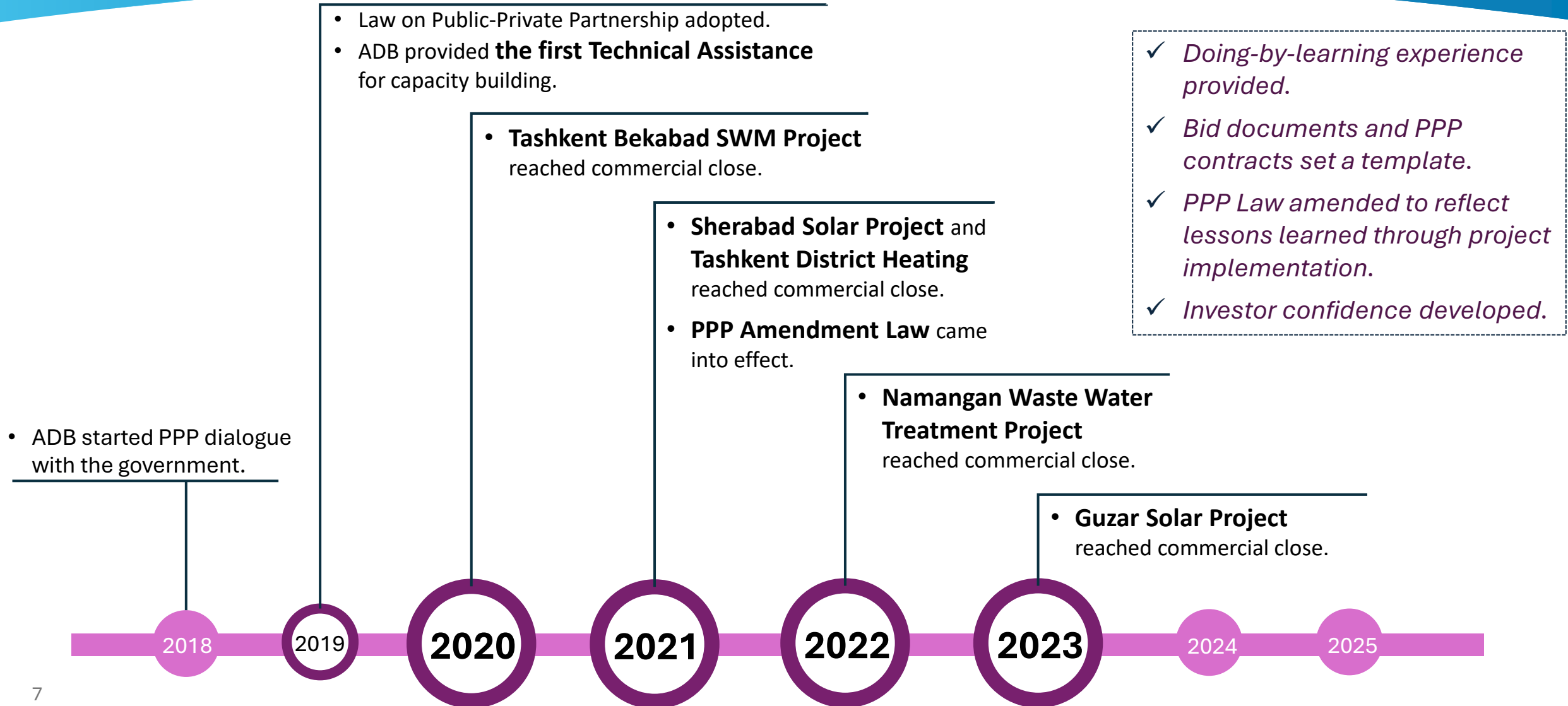
