Omi Brotherhood Menturm

Class 3 OTC Drug

[Features of the drug]

Omi Brotherhood Menturm protects skin from external irritations by forming a coating on the skin surface. Omi Brotherhood Menturm also improves blood circulation and has anti-inflammatory, analgesic, anti-itch, bactericidal and aseptic effects. It can be used for the treatment of skin irritation, burn, razor burn, abrasion, insect bite, and bruise, etc.

Consultation is required:

1. Consult your doctor, pharmacist, or registered seller before use

- (1) if you are under the medical care of a physician,
- (2) if you have had allergic reactions to medicines, etc., or
- (3) if you have moist eczema or sore skin.

2. Stop use immediately and consult your doctor, pharmacist, or registered seller with this package insert if any of the following symptoms develop.

Site Symptom

Skin Rash, redness, itching

3. Stop use and consult your doctor, pharmacist, or registered seller with this package insert, if the condition does not improve within 5 to 6 days.

[Ingredients, strength]

dl-Camphor 9.60%, l-menthol 1.35%, eucalyptus oil 1.30%.

Excipients: white petrolatum 66.44%, yellow petrolatum 16.63%, paraffin 4.00%, titanium oxide 0.10%, turpentine oil 0.36%, methyl salicylate 0.22%.

[Indications] Abrasion, burn, chilblains, insect bite, razor burn, cut, bruise, nerve pain, itch, sore foot, dry and chapped skin, muscular rheumatism, skin inflammation.

[Directions] Apply an appropriate amount of Omi Brotherhood Menturm to the skin, and smooth gently or rub thoroughly into the skin.

Wound treatment:

Apply to skin abrasion, cut area, and sore foot. For a (mild) burn, immediately cool the burn with cold water and apply a thin layer of Omi Brotherhood Menturm. Cover with a gauze dressing and wrap with a bandage if necessary.

Razor burn:

Omi Brotherhood Menturm protects the skin from invisible cuts or razor burn. Using Omi Brotherhood Menturm after shaving is especially refreshing.

Insect bites, itch:

Apply Omi Brotherhood Menturm immediately after being bitten by an insect such as mosquito. It will help relieve itching. It also helps relieve the pain of bruises, nerve pain, and muscle rheumatism.

Chapped skin, chilblains, skin inflammation:

For chapped skin, apply Omi Brotherhood Menturm after cleansing skin. For chilblains, apply it after rubbing the skin to stimulate circulation.

<Precautions for use>

- (1) Use Omi Brotherhood Menturm as directed.
- (2) Please ensure that children only use it under the supervision of a parent or guardian.
- (3) Be careful not to get any of the preparation into your eyes. If this does happen, flush your eyes with cold or lukewarm water. If you have severe symptoms, seek assistance from an eye care professional.
- (4) Omi Brotherhood Menturm is for external use only.

<Precautions for storage and handling>

- (1) Keep the container tightly closed and store in a dry and cool place away from direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer the medicine to any other container to avoid misuse and quality deterioration.
- (4) Do not use beyond the expiration date. Use up contents quickly after opening, even before the expiration date.
