

2027 Ilwoo Foundation Scholarship Program for Mongolian Students for Undergraduate

Overview

1. Academic Programs and Total Candidates for selection

- (1) Bachelor's degree program : up to 2 students (Inha univ : 1/ Aerospace Univ : 1)
 - Fields of Study : Natural sciences or Engineering, Political sciences, economic sciences or Business administration

2. Required Documents

- (2) Deadline of Submission : 2026.04.17 (FRI)
- (3) Documents to be submitted
 - Completed Application Form (on a prescribed form)
 - ☞ Official English grade and certificate should be submitted (IELTS, TOFEL etc)
 - ☞ Official Korean grade(**Over TOPIK level 3**) and certificate **should be submitted.**
 - IWF Pledge (on a prescribed form)
 - Cover letter (on a prescribed form)
 - One Copy of High School and/or University Academic Transcripts(**English**)
 - Any type of portrait that enables interviewers identify you in application form
 - ※ Your portrait needs to be posted on your application form.
- (4) Notes
 - Every document including an application form should be **in one PDF file.**
(file name format : '_family name_given name' ex : _Kim_Jihwan)
 - An application form and other documents should be submitted through email.
 - Application form and other program materials are to be filled out either in Korean or in English.
 - Application doesn't satisfy the format above will be **immediately disqualified.**

Contents

1. Program Objective

The objective of Ilwoo Foundation(IWF) scholarship program is to provide Mongolian students with the opportunities to conduct advanced studies at higher educational institutions in Republic of Korea in order to promote international exchanges in education and mutual friendship between the countries.

2. Qualifications

Prospective applicants must meet the following qualification criteria

- (1) Nationality : Mongolian citizenship is required
- (2) Age and Academic career : Should be under 25years old (Single, unmarried)
- (3) Have an adequate health, both physically and mentally.
 ※ Persons who are pregnant or having severe illness may not apply.
- (4) Have finished formal education of elementary, middle, high school as of May 2025/2026.
- (5) Possess above 80% (out of 100%) in a grade point average (G.P.A.) of the whole school years of the high school attended or within top 10% among graduates in the same year.
- (6) Not at any time have received a scholarship in Republic of Korea for his/her undergraduate study before.
- (7) Not have enrolled in an undergraduate course in Korea before.

3. Scholarship Benefit/Maintenance qualification

(2) Scholarship Payment

- Bachelor's degree : 2027.03.02~2031.02.28 (4 years)
- **Must get over 2.75 Score every semester**(or scholarship is no longer supported)
- someone **give up continuing studying** with personal reasons need to **pay back all the scholarship provided.**

(3) Other Benefits

- Airline ticket : The grantees will receive an airplane ticket or be paid an economy class airfare of the shortest route between their country and Korea when they come to Korea, and, thereafter, when they leave Korea after completion of their study.
- Monthly Allowance: Upon arrival at Korea, the grantee will be provided with about more less USD 450 per month to cover living expenses for the period of his or her program.
- Dormitory Fee
- Tuitions: The full tuition is paid by IWF(under (2) condition).
 ※ Scholars who do not meet the minimum criterion for grades will have to pay the tuition by themselves
- Medical Insurance: The grantees will be provided with health insurance for major accidents and illnesses during their scholarship period.
- Fee for Text book (USD 120 per semester), a graduation thesis

(4) Notes

- IWF does not compensate fees for the domestic travel both in the grantee's country and Korea.
- IWF does not compensate fees for insurance of traveling to and from Korea.
- Any grantee who gives up his/her study during the scholarship period will not receive airfare and allowance for repatriation except for the cases approved by IWF such as severance of diplomatic relations, war or other natural disaster.
- Any grantee who quits the program in 3 months after one's entrance into Korea,

should refund all scholarship fees (The airfare of arriving Korea, monthly allowance, Korean language training expenses, etc.).

4. Other Information

(1) Entry

- Grantees must arrive in Korea by February 28, 2027. In case a grantee does not enter Korea by the date stated above without any special reason, his/her scholarship award could be canceled.
- Grantees are required to get a visa by themselves before arriving in Korea.
 - ※ Visit the Consular section of the Korean embassy or consulate in your country of residence with the guarantee letter from IWF, after being informed of selected as a grantee.
- Every grantee should read the 「Orientation Handout for IWF」 thoroughly before coming to Korea and keep it for reference while staying in Korea, which will be distributed prior to arriving in Korea.
- The payment of the monthly allowance for the first month after arrival in Korea may be delayed due to absence of Korean bank account. Therefore, every grantee is advised to bring extra money to cover the living expenses for the period.

(2) Universities

- Inha University, Korea Aerospace University
- Notes : **The grantee should make a preparation of the required documents for application for an admission to a university by him/herself.**

(3) Cancellation or temporary suspension of Scholarship : If a grantee is found engaged in any of the following activities during his/her stay in Korea, his/her scholarship will be suspended and then will be disqualified from a grantee position.

- When any documents of the scholarship application has been found false.
- When the grantee has violated the written pledge which s/he has given to IWF.
- When the grantee has violated the guidelines and regulations set by IWF.
- When the grantee has been cautioned more than 2 times due to an unexcused absence or a prolonged absence from the Korean language training or the temporary departure without permission or notification
- When the grantee has not earned at least 2/3 of the registered credit courses of the semester.
- When the grantee has not submitted a request for re-enrollment to the university and not notified IWF of re-enrollment without any proper reasons within one month after the period of 'temporary absence from school' has ended.
- When the grantee has given up one's studies.
- The grantee can get only tuition in case of his/her marriage with anyone except Mongolian
- When the grantee severely violates the regulation of the foundation and neglects the grantee's basic duties
- When the grantee is punished with more than a fine by Korean law

(6) Temporary suspension of scholarship

- After the grantee begins his/her study at undergraduate course, s/he should obtain a proper approval from the university where s/he studies and IWF in order to exit Korea, and his/her monthly allowance will be cut for the period of absence exceeding 15 days.
